Dealership Spotlight Ron Magill 30 years & Over 900,000 Miles!

Ron Magill is a familiar face to many and brings a great wealth of knowledge and experience to our dealership. In March, Ron

celebrated his 30th anniversary as a professional motorcycle mechanic!

Ron started riding at age 12, a Honda 70 mini trail. By the age of 14 he had a Honda SL 100 and was very into the dirt bike/motocross scene; however, he had the easy rider poster on his wall and always wanted a Harley. At 17 he got his first big street bike, a 1969 triumph trident 750. At about 20 he got another triumph, a 1969 Bonneville, then came his first Harley, a 1941 Knucklehead (wishes he still had it!) then onto a 1972 Sportster.

In 1986 he bought his present bike, his faithful 1986 FXWG Wide Glide, that has in excess of 900,000 miles on it! at one point he had the XL, 650 triumph and Wide Glide all running at the same time and used the XL for commuting and the Wide Glide for longer trips. The Wide Glide is the only one left and is his daily driver.

Ron started as a professional motorcycle mechanic on March 13, 1989 after graduating from Motorcycle Mechanics Institute (MMI), in Phoenix, AZ.

We look forward to many more years with Ron and are thankful for his dedication!
